
Study To Evaluate The Effectiveness Of Interprofessional Grand Rounds For Implementation Of Effective Interprofessional Collaborative Practice (IPCP)

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Introduction

Interprofessional Collaborative Practice occurs when multiple health workers from different professional backgrounds work together with patients, families, caregivers, and communities to deliver the highest quality of care. Interprofessional Grand Rounds have emerged as a potential strategy to enhance collaboration among healthcare providers from different fields.



Results

The overall agreement level for the IP Grand Round was high. The respondents agreed that the IP Grand Round made patient management more efficient.

The thematic analysis of IP Grand Round responses revealed several key themes reflecting the participants' experiences. The most prominent theme was Interprofessional Collaboration, highlighted by 71.43% of respondents, indicating the strong emphasis on teamwork across different professions.

Aim- To determine the effectiveness of Interprofessional Grand Rounds to implement IPCP.

To evaluate the willingness of various healthcare professionals to work collaboratively under the IPCP framework.

Methodology

An Interprofessional Grand Round was organized on World Hearing Day 2024 at a tertiary care hospital. The event included professionals from various fields—ENT specialists, Audiologists & Speech-Language Pathologists, Clinical Psychologists, Happiness Experts, Nutritionists, Nursing Staff, and Clerical Staff—along with ENT residents and MBBS students. A case was presented to the panel for discussion. After the Interprofessional Grand Round, reflections were taken from all the professionals and students who participated or attended the program.
