
MATERIALS AND METHODS

- 1. EPA Documentation: Descriptions, levels, and entrustment criteria uploaded directly in Sites or via Google Classroom integration (LMS). 2. Recording Trainee Activities: Multimedia uploads, including Google Slides for presentations, videos of procedures, and photomicrographs. 3. Assessment Data Recording: Integration with Google Docs (DOPS checklists, theory tests) and Google Forms (evaluations for case discussions, journal clubs, seminars, MCQs). 4. **Progress Tracking**: Through Sheets Google
- integration. 5. Program of Assessment: Scheduled with Google Calendar integration. 6. Reflection and Feedback **One Stop Solution for Data Tracking** Limitations
- Multi-format content upload (documents, images, videos), data export and reporting options, mentor or faculty review tools

We created a prototype -EPA PathPort using Google Sites






